Cold chain breach protocol

- Immediately isolate the vaccines and prepare to transfer them into temporary monitored vaccine storage, if necessary. Start conditioning ice packs/gel packs.
- Keep vaccines refrigerated between +2°C and +8°C for as long as possible, and label them 'Do not use' while preparing to transfer them.
- Contact your state or territory health department as soon as possible (during business hours).
- Do not discard any vaccine until advised to do so by your state or territory health department.
- 5 Take steps to correct the problem and to prevent it from recurring.
- 6 For privately purchased vaccines, contact the manufacturer for advice.

Reporting a cold chain breach

When notifying your state or territory health department of a cold chain breach, be prepared to report:

- the length of time the temperature of the vaccine refrigerator was outside the +2°C to +8°C temperature range
- 2 the type and number of vaccines in the refrigerator.
